(26) Zulu

There are typos: One is in the word ‘in the path’. In place of a high back rounded vowel [u] there should be a voiced lateral fricative [ɬ]. That is, the word is *éndɬelémi*

Secondly, the word ‘mouth’ should have a final lax vowel: *ùmlòmə*
